Support Us while you shop!

We have a great new way to support us here at Anerley Town Hall and all while you do your weekly shopping. We have been selected by the Coop to receive funding to buy equipment or pay for days out for our elders groups: 'The Eagles' and 'The Pineapple Lunch Club.' We've put together this simple step by step to help you support us while you shop

Here's how you can help

1. Become a member. It costs £1. You can do this online www.coop.co.uk/membership or in store.
2. Once you are a member every time you buy coop branded products and services and present your membership card, 5% of your purchase goes into your coop account which you can redeem in store against the price of your shopping.
3. A further 1% is donated to a charity of your choice. In this case it's us! (Crystal Palace Community Trust)
4. Once you've become a member, you need to register your card online and then choose to back the **CRYSTAL PALACE COMMUNITY TRUST** as your charity. Until you have carried out this step, none of your purchase price will go into the funding pot that we are building up so its really important you remember to register this.

Funding from Veolia for the Old Library Project

Our Old Library Project has been further supported by Veolia Environmental Trust who are providing more than £60K in grant funding towards enhancements to this exciting new project. As you know the project will transform the old library space providing a safe, neutral space for children, young people and families in the Anerley area, with a range of high-quality services, activities and provision.

The project will see the transformation of a largely disused old library at Anerley Town Hall. The anticipated start date for the project is February and we hope to have a completion date of end July enabling us to launch this new facility with a range of summer activities for the community in Anerley.

Did you know we have a hot desking spaces for hire?

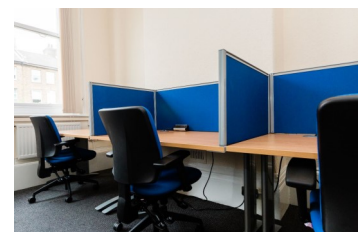
Each desk comes with a telephone line, internet point and use of our kitchen and bathroom facilities.
