A new lease of life for the old library space

The CPCT are delighted to report that we have just received £150K from the Weston Anniversary Fund to develop the disused library space at Anerley Town Hall.

Following a large consultation with the local community and partners, we were able to ascertain that there is a definite need for greater service provision for children, young people and families in the area. Following on from this, we wrote a bid to Garfield Weston including plans drawn up by a local surveyor.

Plans for the disused library space include a large area which can be used by providers to run their services and activities from plus small rooms that can be used for purposes such as counselling and advice services. These spaces will also be available for hire at weekends. In addition, we plan to integrate an affordable community café which will be open to local people including local workers during the daytime.

On Monday 19 November 12-2.30pm we are holding a lunchtime meeting to map the existing youth offer in the area, identify gaps in provision and establish what services and activities could take place in the old library space once it's refurbished. We hope to identify & build a network of providers and supporters. Do you work with or have a passion for children and young people? Come along to our meeting, we'd love to hear your views!
